FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE RULES BELOW WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION

Boundaries:

The northern fishing boundary is the northern breakwater of Swansea channel. The southern fishing boundary is Sydney Harbour South Head. "Outside" fishing is defined as fishing east of a line between the headlands of the waterways within the boundaries. "Inside" fishing is defined as fishing upstream of a line between the headlands of the waterways within the boundaries.

Lines Down: 6:00 p.m. Friday.

Weigh-in:

When fishing competitions against The Grange Hotel Bloody Seagulls Fishing Club or the Bateau Bay Hotel Fishing Club all fish must be in the designated weigh-in area by 2:00 p.m. Sunday. For all other competitions all fish must be in the designated weigh-in area by 3:00 p.m. Sunday.

Excluding squid and crustaceans, all fish must be gilled, gutted and roed. Mutilated fish will not be accepted.

Any fish not specifically listed above are not considered weighable fish and will be awarded no points.

Each competitor's catch must be in separate containers (Separate plastic bags in one esky acceptable).

Any catch exceeding the bag limits, containing under size or over size fish will be disqualified.

Dusky Flathead over 70cm in length:

The taking of dusky flathead over 70cm is illegal. However, one fish may be photograhed on a brag mat as per the club fishing rules and released immediately. Based on the lenght of the fish, points will be awarded based on the weight listed in the length to weight table printed on the DPI Fisheries brag mat minus ten percent (for gills, intestines, etc.).
